The Foundation makes grants to nonprofit organizations to improve the quality of life in the Coastal Bend area of Texas from unrestricted, field-of-interest, designated, special project and donor advised funds. Let's Fix It was introduced to the community in 2017.

The Foundation provides scholarships and fellowships to students in accordance with the terms of the approximate 100 scholarship and fellowship funds.

On November 14, 2017 the Foundation had a one 24 hour period on online giving of donations called the "Coastal Bend Day of Giving", where 25 donors matched the first \$800,000 collected for 45 nonprofits in the Coastal Bend service area. The total amount granted to the 45 nonprofits was \$2,224,690 which provided assistance to over 35,000 Coastal Bend residents.

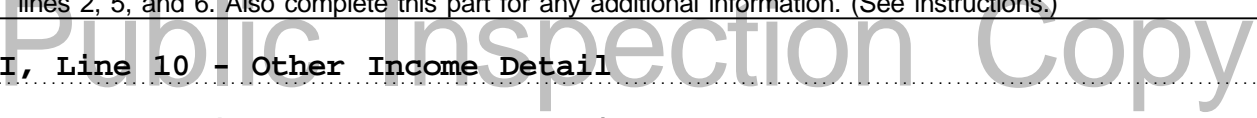
